- NAVTTC is apex body for Technical and Vocational Education Training (TVET) sector in the country. It is mandated to promote, facilitate, regulate, strategize, revamp, approve curricula, train, and provide policy direction for country's entire Technical & Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and skill development system in the country.
- NAVTTC has made major contribution to national human resource development and has generated a large number of employments for the skilled youth, overseas and nationally, benefitting the individuals as well as the national economy. Some key achievements of NAVTTC are: 650,000 youth trained as certified skilled professionals in different demand driven trades with 71% employment ratio.
- National Vocational and Technical Training Commission (NAVTTTC), Government of Pakistan, invites Request for Proposals (RFP) from potential TRAINING PARTNERS (Software houses, IT firms, Universities, IT Entities, IT Parks & Companies / Joint Ventures / Consortiums etc) / Public or Private Sector, to run the High-TECH / Information Technology short-courses of NAVTTC under program titled; **"Prime Minister's Youth Skill Development."** These potential Training partners will be required to equip youth with demand-driven income generating skills, leading to employment and self-employment in IT industry. The Quality based selection criteria method as provided in PC-I and approved by the CDWP of Planning Commission will be used for short-listing of Training partners. The detailed assessment parameters are available in the bidding document and also on NAVTTC Portal.
- A potential applicant Training partners must be registered/ affiliated/ accredited with relevant government authority / Law / international agencies and also having the **Biometric Attendance machines and automated attendance management system** facility to be further verified / synchronized with authentic data base services.
- For an applicant Software House / IT company, it must be registered affiliated with Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) or Security Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) and a university must be fully chartered and established through a legislative act of respective government and approved / recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC), Pakistan.
- Detailed requirements for potential training partners, training proposal and the application forms are available on NAVTTC website (www.navttc.gov.pk). The potential applicant training partners are mandatorily required to apply on NAVTTC's online Project Management System (PMS) link: <https://nsis.navttc.gov.pk/> w.e.f. 20th September 2023 and by no later than 5th October 2023 (2400 Hrs).
- Hardcopies of (online filled-in) form along with supporting documents must reach concerned NAVTTC Regional Office (given below) by no later than 07-10-2023 (3:00 PM). The bids shall be opened on 07-10-2023 (5:00 PM). Qualifying Training partners will be informed formally.
- The process shall be governed under the applicable Rules and NAVTTC reserves the rights to reject any application at any time prior to the acceptance, for any reason, including inter alia unsatisfactory past record; poor training proposals; limited post-training employment / placement prospects; not supported with requisite documents; etc.
